Notes:

Thomas Innes of Learney's letter to Gartaneaglais 25 Jul 1931 implies that Gartaneaglais believed he was descended from Gilbert b Inveresk 1784, and had a letter from Jane Innes of Stow, Picardy Place and a fragile marriage certificate 1808. (above Gilbert Innes and Betty Lennox)

Thomas Innes of Learney in letter 14 Feb 1958 states he finds that Alexander Innes warehouse manager in Leith, 3rd son of Gilbert Innes in Rora and Torterston left 3 natural children, Gilbert and 2 daughters. He feels that this Gilbert Innes is the one who founded Gartaneaglais's line. The dates and circumstances fit exactly.

Letter 20 Sep 1833 from Jane Innes to Gilbert Innes, Dalmarnok Manufactory, no 7 Cumberland St, Calton, Glasgow and stock transfer dated 10 Jan 1840 to Gilbert Innes manager of the Dalmarnock Works £300 being part of his interest or share in the Capital Stock of the Royal Bank of Scotland are in Ref 615.

Arms of Gartaneaglais, matriculated 23 July 1958, [Lyon Reg 43/7]
Argent, a chevronel wavy Sable between three mullets Azure; within a bordure per pale, dexter engrailed Sable, sinister compony Azure and Or.
Crest: An estoile of twelve rays Azure, charged with a cross-crosslet Argent.
Motto: Me Luce.
