

Family of James Innes and Christian Honeyman

1.i. On 27 Nov 1803 **James Innes** and **Christian Honeyman**, both this parish, were married (OPR Scot 420 vol.3 fr825 ²).

2.i. **David Innes**, son of James Innes, master builder and Christina Honeyman was born about 1811. He married **Mary Higginson** (birth and marriages records not seen, birth date calculated from age at death, and wife's name taken from David's death record in 1872).

David Innes, builder (master), widower of **Mary Higginson**, died 2 Dec 1872 5:30 AM at Kirkgate, Cupar, age 61, s/o **James Innes** builder (master) deceased and **Christina Honeyman** deceased. Informant James Innes 3 No? St, Birmingham, son (BMD D 1872 420 ¹).

2.ii. Janet Innes d/o **James Innes** mason and **Christian Honeyman** was born about 1819 or 1821 (record not seen, years calculated from age at marriage and death).

On 2 Feb 1858 at Kirkgate, Cupar, Church of Scotland, **Janet Innes**, age 37, married **George Dick**, age 44, Cupar Fife, Sergeant, Fife Militia Artillery s/o Robert Dick, weaver deceased & Janet Campbell, Witness James Innes, David Innes. Janet is the d/o **James Innes**, mason deceased and **Christian Honeyman**. (BMD M 1858 420 ⁴).

Janet Dick, widow of George Dick, military pensioner died 28 Dec 1898 at 22 Kirkgate, Cupar, age 79 d/o (**name not given**) **Innes**, mason master, deceased and (**name not given**) **Honeyman** deceased. Informant David Innes nephew, Stately Bridge (BMD D 1898 420 ⁵).

2.iii. James Innes was born 6 Sep 1834 to **James Innes**, mason, and **Christian Honeyman** his spouse, baptised 27th (OPR Scot 420 vol.3 fr834 ³). James Innes was the informant at the death of his father in 1872.
