2.i. John Wilson Innes, s/o **John Innes** master builder & **Catherine ms Wilson** married 18 Feb 1867 at Glasgow, was born 6 Dec 1867 at Springbank, Skelmonlie, Largs (BMD B 1867 602 <sup>1</sup>).

**John Wilson Innes**, iron moulder jny 198 Cumberland St., UP Church, , married **Georgina Weir** 10 Jun 1891, John is the s/o **John Innes** prison governor deceased & **Catherine McKechnie ms Wilson** (BMD M 1891 644/12 <sup>2</sup>).

3.i. Elizabeth Richmond Innes, d/o **John Wilson Innes & Georgina Weir** was born 1 Dec 1899 at 43 Buchan St., Glasgow (BMD B 1899 644/12 <sup>3</sup>).

3.ii. John Wilson Innes, s/o **John Wilson Innes & Georgina Weir**, was born 17 Oct 1902 at 12 Pine St., Glasgow (BMD B 1902 644/1 <sup>4</sup>).

2.ii. Catherine McKechnie Innes, d/o **John Innes** mason (master) & **Catherine ms Wilson** m 18 Feb 1867 at Glasgow was born 14 Feb 1869 at Hope Villa, Skelmorlie, Largs. Informant father. (BMD B 1869 602 <sup>5</sup>).

2.iii. Elizabeth Innes was born 28 Sep 1873 at Upper Skelmortis, Largs, d/o **John Innes** builder master & **Catherine ms Wilson** married 18 Feb 1867 at Glasgow. Informant father. (BMD B 1873 602 <sup>6</sup>).

**Elizabeth Innes** sp age 20 150 Stobcross St., Glasgow, was married on 7 Oct 1903 at 42 West Nile St., Glasgow, by declaration in presence of John Wilson Innes iron moulder 62 Waddell St., Glasgow & Georgina Dick or Innes residing there to **William Parker Dick**, shipping clerk bachelor age 27 residing 150 Stobcross St., Glasgow, s/o James Dick whipmaker deceased & Elizabeth ms Richmond. By warrant Sheriff Substitute of Lanarkshire, Oct 7 1893. Elizabeth is the d/o **John Innes** prison superintendant & **Catherine McKechnie ms Wilson** (BMD M 1893 644/7 <sup>7</sup>).
