

Family of Alexander Innes and Catherine Ross

- 1.i. **Alexander** Innes, schoolmaster married **Catherine Ross** before 1778 and had children:
 - 2.i. Campbell Innes s/o **Alexander Innes** schoolmaster of parish of Logie Easter, Ross, & **Catherine Ross** his spouse was baptised 6 Nov 1778 at Logie Easter (OPR 77/1) (see below)
 - 2.ii. William Innes s/o **Alexander Innes** session clerk & **Katherine Ross** baptised at Logie school 6 May 1780 (OPR 77/1)
 - 2.iii. John Innes s/o **Alexander Innes** schoolmaster & **Catherine Ross** baptised at Logie Easter 22 Mar 1783 (OPR 77/1)
 - 2.iv. Walter Innes s/o **Alexander Innes** schoolmaster & **Catherine Ross** baptised at Logie Easter 22 Mar 1783 (OPR 77/1)
 - 2.v. Pryse Innes d/o **Alexander Innes** schoolmaster & **Catherine Ross** baptised at Logie Easter 16 Nov 1785 (OPR 77/1)
 - 2.vi. Grisel Innes d/o **Alexander Innes** schoolmaster & **Catherine Ross** baptised at Logie Easter 15 May 1790 (OPR 77/1)
 - 2.vii. Alexander Innes s/o **Alexander Innes** schoolmaster & **Catherine Ross** baptised at Logie Easter 29 Jul 1796 (OPR 77/1)
 - 2.viii. William Munro Innes s/o **Alexander Innes** schoolmaster & session clerk and **Catherine Ross** born at Logie Easter 14 Jun 1804 (OPR 77/1)

2.i. **Campbell Innes** and **Jean Drysdale** were married 21 Jul 1798 at Bo'Ness parish, having confirmed they had been irregularly married 14 Aug 1797 (OPR 663/5)

- 3.i. Jane Innes lawful daughter born 1 July baptised 13 Aug 1798 at Bo'Ness, the father designed as clerk to John Taylor & Sons (OPR 663/4).

Jane Innes married 8 Oct 1824, as eldest daughter of Campbell Innes, Esq, Chief Magistrate of the burgh of Queensferry, to **George Charles**, parish of St Cuthberts, son of Robert Charles of Queensferry and Jane Aitchison his spouse (OPR 670/2 fr427).

Jane Innes died at age 88 on 22 Aug 1886 at the Schoolhouse, parish of Dull in Perthshire, informant her son-in-law A. MacNaughton (BMD D 1886 346).

3.ii. Munro Innes son of **Campbell Innes** soap manufacturer & **Jean Drysdale** was born at Queensferry 12 Feb 1800 (OPR 670/1 fr 258)

3.iii. Elisabeth Innes daughter of Mr. **Campbell Innes** soap manufacturer and **Jean Drysdale** was born at Queensferry 13th baptized 18th Jan 1802 (OPR 670/1 fr261).

Elisabeth Innes married (1) 8 Aug 1825 to **John Cowie** merchant No 36 West Richmond St Edinburgh (St Cuthberts(OPR 685 2 /40 fr619) Aug 1825 at Queensferry OPR 670/2 fr427 8) and (2) as Mrs. Elisabeth Innes or Cowie, she married 1 Jun 1834 at Queensferry to Mr. **Elias Johnston**, master of the burgh school by Rev. Mr. Femms (?) (OPR 670 fr432)

Elisabeth Innes died 14 Jul 1869 age 65 at St Boswell's, parish of Roxburgh, informant Phyllis [Prysella] Dickson, her sister (BMD D 1869 804)

3.iv. Alexander Innes b 26 Jun baptized 1Jul 1804 at Queensferry (OPR 670 fr267)

3.v. **William Innes** baptized 6 Mar 1807 (OPR 670/1 fr274 12). He was a bank teller with Sir William Forbes & Co. in Edinburgh. He married **Margaret Maule Cramond** 18 Aug 1834 residing at 63 Cumberland St, Edinburgh OPR 685 1 /64 fr395 13. He died 1 Apr 1878 (BMD D 1878 685/1)

4.i. Margaret Maule Cramond Innes, daughter of **William Innes** clerk in Sir William Forbes & Co's bank residing No 8 Cumberland St, and **Margaret Maule Cramond** his spouse was born 14 May, baptised 24 Jun 1840 at Edinburgh (St Cuthberts OPR 685 2 /35 fr2446)

4.ii. Campbell Innes, son of **William Innes** of Union Bank of Scotland residing at 8 Great Stuart St and his spouse **Margaret Maule Cramond**, was born 27 Jan 1854 at Edinburgh, baptised 10 Mar by Rev. James W Letchie one of the ministers of the High Church in Edinburgh (St Cuthberts (OPR 685 2 /37 fr9717). He died 5 Jul 1858 at 8 Great Stewart St, Edinburgh age 4 ½ and was buried in western cemetery, Edinburgh (BMD D 1858 685/1).

3.vi. John Innes born and baptized 19th Jul 1809 at Queensferry (OPR 670/1 fr281). He was a surgeon with the East India Company maritime service and died 6 Mar 1859 at the Royal Edinburgh Asylum (W Div) Morningside age 49 and is buried in the Dean cemetery (BMD D 1859 685/1).

3.vii. Katharine Innes baptized 13 Dec 1811 lawful daughter of **Campbell Innes** by **Jean Drysdale** at Queensferry (OPR 670/1 fr286).

Katherine Innes married (1) **William Rose**, maltster and (2) **Andrew Armour** wire rope manufacturer's agent (records not found). She died in the district of Kinning Park 15 Nov 1891 age "about 83" at 22 (10) Queen Square, Strathbuns, Glasgow, informant her nephew Hugh Innes (BMD D 1891 644/14) .

3.viii. **Martha Evans Innes** baptized 1 Jun 1814 at Queensferry (OPR 670/1 fr293 22). She married in Queensferry 27 Oct 1837 to Mr. **David Russell** grocer (OPR 670/2 fr433).

3.ix. Prysella Innes born 18 Sep 1816, at Queensferry, baptism witnessed by George Charles & John Gordon resident at Queensferry (OPR 670/1 fr300). She died 3 Oct 1891 at 7 Weirhill Pl, Melrose age 76, daughter of **Campbell Innes** and **Jane ms Drysdale** deceased (BMD D 1891 799).

Prysella Innes death record states she married **James Dickson** schoolmaster (marriage record not found) and had a step son "J" Dickson who as informant at her death was living at 20 Charing Cross (mansions?) Glasgow.

3.x. Grace Innes born 8 Apr 1820 at Queensferry (OPR 670/2 fr300)

Grace Innes married 24 Dec 1854 at Barony to **Adam Carse** hat manufacturer, parish of St John's Newcastle on Tyne (OPR Barony 622/21 fr6037) daughter of Campbell Innes soap manufacturer & Jane Drysdale .

Recorded in statutory records as 17 Jan 1855 age 34 at No 2 Russell St to Adam Carse #2 West Russell St usually at 28 Lancaster St, St Johns parish Newcastle on Tyne age 30 latter b Leith 16 Nov 1825 son of Duncan Carse seaman & ?, witnessed by Priscilla Innes, Elizabeth Johnston (statutory registration Anderston District, Glasgow M 1855 644/6).

Grace Innes age 51 daughter of Campbell Innes and Jane Drysdale both deceased, died 28 Dec 1873 at 20 Lawrence Pl, Partick (BMD D 1873 646/3).
