1.i. **John McInnes** married 12 Jun 1810 to **Margaret McMillan** in Creich, Mull, parish of Kilfinichen and Kilvickeon, Argyll. (OPR 542)

2.i. Donald McInnes, (later **Daniel Innes**) baptised 13 May 1811 in Boneside, Argyle (from death certificate. Bonessan is parish church of Killicheuchen) 18 Dec 1831 m (1) in United Secession Church, Port Eglinton, Glasgow to **Janet McLachlane**, Anderston, b 1808 to John McLachlan and Helen Porter in Barony, d 9 Mar 1836 at Dundee.

Daniel Innes d 17 Oct 1882 age 70 (reg'd 17 Oct 1882). in Dundee Trades Directory as hairdresser, sometimes master barber, 1834, 1837/8 at Castle St, 1841-1843 35 Castle St, 1846/47 Trades Hall, 3 Murraygate House, 4 Gellatly St. 1850 3 Murraygate. 1851 census, next heard of in Caithness.
