

Family of William Innes and Jane Hay

- 1.i. William Innes in parish of Rathven was born in 1779 [birth record not seen, year calculated from age at death (MI Fochabers - Pre-1855 Gravestone Inscriptions on Speyside, SGS 1974 ¹)].

William Innes and **Jane Hay** of parish of Bellie, contracted 11 Oct 1815 in Rathven (OPR 164 Rathven vol.2 fr 492 ²) and married 5 Nov 1815 in parish of Bellie (OPR 126 Bellie vol.2 fr.293 ³). Jane Hay was born in 1797 [birth record not seen, year calculated from age at death (MI Fochabers 1)].

William Innes died 1 Mar 1848 age 69 and is buried at Fochabers, Bellie (MI Fochabers 1). **Jane Hay** died 31 Mar 1874 age 77 and is buried at Fochabers, Bellie 1 .

- 2.i. Janet Innes d/o **William Innes** shoemaker in Rathven and his wife **Jane Hay**, was born 1 Dec 1816, baptised 8th . Witness George Coul & Alexander McCurrack there. (OPR 164 Rathven vol.1 ³).

Janet Innes married **George Hill**, tinsmith in Banff and died 25 Mar 1890 at Fochabers, age 73, d/o William Innes shoemaker deceased & Jane ms Hay deceased, informant George Hill husband. (BMD D 1890 126 ⁴)

- 2.ii. William Innes s/o **William Innes** shoemaker & **Jean Hay** was born 1818 (birth record not seen, year calculated from age at death). At Bellie, William Innes laborer single died 19 Nov 1871 at Fochabers, age 53, s/o **W. Innes** shoemaker & **Jean Hay**. Informant Joseph Innes brother.” (BMD D 1871 126 ⁵ and MI Fochabers)

- 2.iii. Jane Innes, d/o **William Innes** shoemaker in Rathven and **wife Jane Hay** b 1 Dec 1819 baptised 8th . Witness George Coul & Alexander McCurrack there.(OPR 164 Rathven vol. 1. Baptisms ⁶)).

Jane Innes and **Alexander Petrie** btp contracted 13 Jan 1849 and married 30th (OPR 126 Bellie vol.3 fr 758 ⁷). Jane and Alexander had a son William who was the informant at Jane’s death. On 13 Feb 1891 at Auchneath, **Jane (Innes) Petrie** died, widow of **Alexander Petrie** farmer, d/o **William Innes** shoemaker deceased & **Jane ms Hay** deceased. Informant William Petrie son (BMD D 1891 168/1 ⁸)

- 2.iv. James Innes son of **William Innes** in Rathven and his wife **Jane Hay** was born 6 Jun 1822. Witness James Wilson, James Reid (OPR 164 Rathven vol.3 Baptisms 1820-54 ca p.176 ⁹).

- 2.v. Jane Innes, twin of Barbara, d/o **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jane Hay**, was born 27 July 1824. Witness George Coul, Alexander Simpson. (OPR 164 Rathven vol.3 Baptisms 1820-54 ca p.175 ¹⁰).
- 2.vi. Barbara Innes, twin of Jane, d/o **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jane Hay**. was born 27 July 1824. Witness George Coul, Alexander Simpson (OPR 164 Rathven vol.3 Baptisms 1820-54 ca p.175 9).
- 2.vii. Penuel Innes, d/o **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jean Hay**, was born 4 Feb 1828. Witness James Allan & John Coull. (OPR 164 Rathven fr 808 ¹¹).

On 27 Dec 1856 at Fochabers F.C. **Penuel Innes** married **William Johnston**, age 20, s/o George Johnston laborer deceased & Helen Moir, by David Dewar minister. Witness James Innes, Alexander Hendry. (BMD M 1856 126 ¹²).

- 2.viii. Isabella Innes, d/o **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jane Hay** was baptised at Rathven 20 Mar 1830. Witness Isabella Donald & James Duncan (OPR 164 Rathven ca fr.816-836 ¹³).

Isabella Innes married 1874 **John Grant** of Grant Arms Hotel, widower, Fochabers. Witness Alexander Milne, Robert Williamson (BMD M 1874 126 ¹⁴). John Grant died 30 May 1882 age 58. Isabella died at Innes Cottage, Fochabers 16 Jul 1909 age 79. They had a daughter Janet who died 25 Mar 1890 age 73 1 (13?).

- 2.ix. Alexander Innes, son of **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jean Hay** was baptised 28 May 1832. Witness Alexander McRae, James Duncan.(OPR 164 Rathven ca fr.816-836 ¹⁵).
- 2.x. Hannah Innes d/o **William Innes** shoemaker Fochabers & **Jane Hay** was born 13 Aug 1834 baptised 17th . Witness John Jamieson & James Galt (OPR 126 Bellie vol.2 fr 667 ¹⁶).

On 11 Dec 1857 at Tobago St., F.C. Dean Boroughmuirhead & Morningside, **Hannah Innes** age 23 residing Straiton, Liberton married **Alexander Hendry** 24 residing Dalkeith s/o Alexander Hendry wright & Ann Bowroman. Witness John Henderson, Joseph Innes. Hannah is the d/o **William Innes** shoemaker & **Jane Hay** (BMD M 1857 685/1 ¹⁷).

- 2.xi. Joseph Innes s/o **W. Innes** shoemaker Fochabers and **Jane Hay** was born 13 Sep 1836, afterwards baptised before witnesses (OPR 126 Bellie vol.2 fr 680 ¹⁸).

On 20 Mar 1863 at Cramond Bridge, parish of Dalmeny C of S, **Joseph Innes** cabinet maker bachelor 26 res Edinburgh married **Margaret Cooper** domestic servant spinster 27 Edinburgh, d/o William Cooper contractor deceased & James ms Cooper. Witness William Hendry, Marion Bird. Joseph is the , s/o **William Innes** shoemaker deceased & **Jane ms Hay** (BMD M 1863 665 ¹⁹).

“11 Oct 1815. **William Innes** parish Rathven & **Jane Hay** this parish contracted & after married.”

3: OPR 164 Rathven vol.2 Marriages
“5 Nov 1815 **William Innes** this parish & **Jane Hay** parish Bellie.”

3: OPR 186 Rathven vol.1
“1 Dec 1816. **William Innes** shoemaker in Rathven wife **Jane Hay** (a daughter) baptised 8th (named) Janet. Witness George Coul & Alexander McCurrach there.”

“**Janet (Innes) Hill** m to **George Hill** tinsmith Banff died 25 Mar 1890 at Fochabers, age 73, d/o William Innes shoemaker deceased & Jane ms Hay deceased, informant George Hill husband.”

5: BMD D 1871 126
“At Bellie, William Innes laborer (s) died 19 Nov 1871 at Fochabers. male 53 s/o **William Innes** shoemaker & **Jean Hay** Informant Joseph Innes brother.”

6: OPR 164 Rathven vol. 1. Baptisms

“1 Dec 1819 **William Innes** shoemaker in Rathven and wife **Jane Hay** daughter Jane b 1 Dec 1819 baptised 8th . Witness George Coul & Alexander McCurrack there.”

“**Alexander Petrie & Jane Innes** btp contracted 13, m 30 Jan 1849.”

“**Jane (Innes) Petrie** widow of **Alexander Petrie** farmer d 13 Feb 1891 Auchneath female age 16 [?] d/o **William Innes** shoemaker deceased & **Jane ms Hay** deceased. Informant William Petrie son.”

“ 6 Jun 1822 **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jane Hay** b son James. Witness James Wilson, James Reid.”

10: OPR 164 vol.3 Baptisms 1820-54 ca p.175

“27 July 1824 **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jane Hay** b twin daughters Jane & Barbara. Witness George Coul & Alexander Simpson in Rathven.”

11: OPR 164 Rathven vol. 3 baptisms 1820-54 fr808.

“4 Feb 1828 **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jean Hay** b daughter baptised Penuel. Witness James Allan & John Coull.”

“Bellie 27 Dec 1856 at Fochabers F.C. **William Johnston** 20 Nether Dallachy farm servant bachelor married **Penuel Innes** 27 Fochabers spinster d/o William Innes shoemaker deceased & Jane Hay. By David Dewar [?] mnister. Witness James Innes, Alexander Hendry. William is the s/o **George Innes** laborer deceased & **Helen Moir** ”

“20 Mar 1830 **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jane Hay** b daughter baptised Isabella. Witness Isabella Donald & James Duncan.”

14: BMD M 1874 126

“at Bellie, 24 Jul 1874 at Castle Row, Fochabers F.C. **John Grant** innkeeper widower 50 High St., Fochabers, s/o Samuel Grant farmer deceased & Grace Robertson domestic servant deceased, married **Isabella Innes** spinster 40 Castle Row, Fochabers, d/o **W. Innes** shoemaker master deceased & **Jane Innes ms Hay** deceased. Witness Alexander Milne, Robert Williamson.

15: OPR 186 Rathven vol.3 Baptisms 1820-1854 between fr 816 and 836
“28 May 1832 **William Innes** in Rathven and wife **Jean Hay** b son baptised Alexander. Witness Alexander McRae, James Duncan.”

“17 Aug 1834. Hannah Innes do **William Innes** shoemaker Fochabers & **Jane Hay** b 13 baptised 17th Aug 1834. Witness John Jamieson & James Galt.”

“Dean Boroughhead & Morningside, 11 Dec 1857 at Tobago St F.C.
Alexander Hendry 24 residing Dalkeith bachelor s/o Alexander Hendry wright & Ann Bowroman married **Hannah Innes** 23 residing Straiton, Liberton spinster d/o **William Innes** shoemaker & **Jane Hay**. Witness John Henderson, Joseph Innes.”

“Joseph Iso **W. Innes** shoemaker Fochabers & **Jane Hay** b 13 Sep 1836 afterwards baptised before witnesses.”

19: BMD M 1863 665
“20 Mar 1863 at Cramond Bridge, parish Dalmeny, C of S, **Joseph Innes** cabinet maker bachelor 26 Edinburgh married **Margaret Cooper** domestic servant spinster 27 Edinburgh d/o William Cooper contractor deceased & Jane ms Cooper. Witness William Hendry, Marion Bird. Joseph is the s/o **William Innes** shoemaker deceased & **Jane ms Hay**”
