

## Family of Charles Innes and Ann Scott

- 1.i. **Charles Innes** masonry labourer married before 1787 to **Ann Scott** (or Scotland <sup>1</sup>).
- 2.i. **Charles Innes** born 29 Oct 1787 at Haddington <sup>2</sup>, plasterer in the Dean, married (1) 3 Oct 1811 at Canongate to **Ann Irvine** <sup>3</sup>.
  - 3.i. **Peter Innes** born 1817 <sup>4</sup>, plasterer, m (1) 25 Dec 1840 at St Cuthbert's, Edinburgh (residing at 153 Rose St.) to **Jean Watt**, living at No. 5 Brighton St., daughter of James Watt, mason in Carnegie St, deceased. <sup>5</sup>  
Peter Innes and Jane Watt had a child.
    - 4.i. **Catherine Innes** born 1843 married 30 Jul 1868 at age 25 resided at 65 Frederick St. Edinburgh to **John Knox Brydon**, mason journeyman age 22, son of James Brydon builder, master deceased and Agnes Knox <sup>6</sup>.  
The couple was divorced 12 Jan 1878. <sup>7</sup>
  - 3.i **Peter Innes** m (2) 12 Jun 1848 residing at 153 Rose St, Edinburgh to **Dorothea Adams** (or Wallace) resided 186 Rose St. daughter of James Adams merchant, Corstorphine, master grocer, and Helen Adams, & widow of late Matthew Wallace, joiner. <sup>8</sup>
    - 4.1 Dorothea Thomson Innes died 28 May 1877, age 58, at 65 Frederick St, Edinburgh. <sup>9</sup>
  - 3.i **Peter Innes** m (3) **Janet Miller** as shown on the death record of Peter Innes. Peter Innes died 5 Feb 1879 at No.9 Buccleuch Pl, St Giles par, Edinburgh <sup>10</sup>
- 2.i **Charles Innes** m (2) 19 Nov 1849 at Leith, residing at 153 Rose St, Edinburgh to **Catherine Salter** residing No.17 Charlotte St., Leith, daughter of the late James Salter, blacksmith, Craik <sup>11</sup>
- 2.i **Charles Innes** m (3) 4 Mar 1857 at 13 Maidowell St, Presbyterian Dissenters, residence 46 Thistle St, Edinburgh age 68 to **Jessie Webster** age 43, daughter of James Webster shipmaster deceased and Janet Morres deceased. <sup>12</sup> Charles Innes died at 46 Thistle St, Edinburgh 6 May 1862 age 73. <sup>13</sup>
- 2.ii. **Catherine Innes** baptised 10 Oct 1790 at Haddington <sup>14</sup> married **William Emslie**, died 10 Aug 1874, 2 Brown's Court, Canongate <sup>15</sup>
- 2.iii. **William Innes** bap 29 Apr 1792 at Cramond. <sup>16</sup> On 13 Sep 1816 at Leith South. William, plasterer in Path head, Kirkcaldy married **Jean** (or Joan) **Gibson** residing in Leith, daughter of John Gibson, tailor there and Church Beadle. <sup>17</sup> William, master plasterer died at Hill Place, Kirkcaldy, Fife 18 Nov 1872 buried at Kirkcaldy churchyard. <sup>19</sup> Jean died 3 May 1873 age 79 (born 1794) and is buried there.

- 3.i. Charles Gibson Innes born 19 Oct 1817 at Dysart <sup>20</sup>. Charles Gibson Innes died 9 Apr 1835, age 18 1/2, buried at Kirkcaldy.
- 3.ii. James Innes, born 29 Aug 1819 at Kirkcaldy, son of **William Innes** and **Jean Gibson** <sup>21</sup>.
- 3.iii. William R Innes born 1821, died 27 Jan 1842 at Kirkcaldy age 21.
- 3.iv. **Agnes Innes** born 26 Nov 1824 at Kirkcaldy <sup>22</sup>, married 5 Sep 1847 at Kirkcaldy to Captain **James Bulloch** <sup>23</sup> (born 1819, died 15 Jan 1859 at Kirkcaldy age 40 ) and died at Kirkcaldy 18 May 1858 age 34 <sup>24</sup>.
- 3.v. **Ann Innes** born 25 Nov 1826 at Kirkcaldy <sup>25</sup>, married 12 Jan 1846 at Kirkcaldy to **James Moyes**, seaman, son of John Moyes, seaman <sup>26</sup>. James Moyes and Ann Innes had a son.
- 4.i. John Moyes born 1848, died 2 Aug 1852 at Kirkcaldy, age 4
- 3.vi. **Rosina Minden Innes** born about 1829, married 13 Jun 1855 to **Archibald MacDougall** (she res 3 St Bernards Pl - 3 rd daughter of William Innes plasterer res Kirkcaldy) <sup>27</sup>, died 16 Apr 1859, 5 Deanhaugh St., Edinburgh age 30 buried Rosebank cemetery <sup>28</sup>
- 3.vi. Grace Salmond Innes born 22 Sep 1829 at Kirkcaldy <sup>29</sup>
- 3.vii. John Innes baptised 3 Apr 1832 at Kirkcaldy <sup>30</sup>
- 2.iv.** William Innes born 13 Jun 1803 to **Charles Innes**, carter, Water of Leith and **Ann Scott**, baptised at St Cuthbert's, Edinburgh <sup>31</sup> may have been another son.
