

Family of David Innes and Helen (Williamina) Baillie

- 1.i. David Innes was born in 1834-5 (birth record not seen, year calculated from age at marriage and death).

On 11 Dec 1857 at Ballemy, parish Currie, U.P. church, David Innes, age 22 parish of Eddlestone a bachelor s/o **David Innes** weaver & Christian Mitchell, married **Williamina Baillie** (record reads William Scott, who is the minister, but indexed as Williamina Baillie b) age 25 d/o Alexander Baillie ploughman & Jane ms Laing, by William Scott minister, witness Thomas Jenikson, Isabella Baillie (BMD M 1857 682 ¹).

David is described as retired at the marriage of his son Angus 13 Dec 1901 (BMD M 1896 662/1).

David Innes railway surfaceman, widower of Helen Baillie, died 21 Feb 1904 at Oakbank, Kirknewton age 70. Informant his son David Innes, 38 Balfour St., Leith (BMD D 1904 690 ²). Helen Baillie, wife of David Innes, platelayer died 11 Nov 1881 at Kirknewton, age 45 (born 1836) d/o Alexander Baillie, dairyman & Jane ms Laing (BMD D 1881 690 ³).

- 2.i. Jane Innes was born 13 Dec 1859 at Craighburn, Eddlestone, d/o **David Innes** railway plate layer & **Helen ms Baillie**, informant David Innes father (BMD B 1857 760 ⁴).

On 14 Oct 1881 at 5 Wellington Pl, Leith, Church of Scotland, **Jane Innes**, domestic servant age 24 residing 11 Hermitage Place, Leith a married **James Gilmore**, cooper journeyman age 24 residing 4 Poplar Lane, Leith, s/o Charles Gilmore stoker marine and Janet ms Muirhead. By James Park, minister of ? parish. Witness John Gilmore, Christine Innes. Jane is d/o **David Innes** platelayer & **Helen ms Buckey** (BMD M 1881 692/2 ⁵).

Jane died 7 Feb 1900 at 22 Pefferbank, Craigmiller, Ligerton age 42, d/o David Innes plate layer & Helen ms Baillie deceased. Informant James Gilmour, widower. (BMD D 1900 693#11 ⁶).

- 2.ii. Christian Kerr Innes was born 19 Aug 1859 at Leadburn, d/o David Innes railway laborer & Helen ms Baillie, informant David Innes father (BMD B 1859 697 ⁷).

On 7 Nov 1884 at the Manse, Kirknewton, Church of Scotland, **Christian K. Innes** sp age 26 res Oakbank d/o David Innes plate layer

& Helen ms Kerr deceased (sic) married **James Quit**, shale miner age 22 res Oakbank, Kirknewton, s/o Samuel Quit retortman at oil works & Mary ms Boyd, by Henry Wallis Smith, minister Kirknewton, East Calder. Witness Robert Shepherd, Annie Innes (BMD M 1884 690 ⁸).

- 2.iii. David Innes was born 20 Jun 1862 at Leadburn, s/o David Innes railway labourer & Helen ms Baillie (married 11 Dec 1857 at Currie), informant David Innes father (BMD B 1862 597 ⁹).

On 24 Nov 1882 at the manse, South Leith., Church of Scotland, **David Innes** age 20 engine turner journeyman residing 144 Cathcart, Leith, married **Elizabeth Sharp** age 21 domestic servant 49 Charlotte St., Leith. d/o William Sharp, oil refiner & Helen ms Richardson, by James Mitchell, minister So Leith, Witness George Weir, Christina Innes. David is s/o **David Innes** railway surfaceman & **Helen ms Baillie** deceased (BMD M 1882 692/2 ¹⁰).

- 2.iv. Alexander Innes was born 14 July 1864 at Leadburn, s/o **David Innes** railway plate layer & **Helen ms Baillie** (married 11 Dec 1857 at Currie). Informant David Innes father (BMD B 1864 597 ¹¹). He died 12 Aug 1864 at Leadburn age 4 weeks. Informant, father. (BMD B 1864 697 ¹²).

- 2.v. George Innes was born 14 Jun 1868 at Contract Railway Huts, Mid Calder, s/o **David Innes** plate layer & **Helen ms Baillie** (married 11 Dec 1857 at Balerno, Currie). Informant David Innes father (BMD B 1868 694 ¹³).

George Innes, bricklayer, age 22 married 27 Feb 1891 at Livingstone Village, Church of Scotland **Lizzie Potter** 21 domestic servant residing Livingstone d/o James Potter drainer & Jessie ms Marshall, by Thomas Acton B A minister. Witness William Sharp, Agnes Potter. George is s/o **David Innes** plate layer & **Ellen ms Baillie** deceased. (BMD M 1891 669 ¹⁴).

- 2.vi. Alexander Innes born 4 May 1871 at Oakbank, parish of Kirknewton, son of **David Innes** platelayer on railway & **Helen ms Baillie** (married 11 Dec 1856 at Ballemy, Currie) (BMD B 1871 690 ¹²). He died 12 Aug 1878 at Oakbank, Kirknewton, age 7 s/o **David Innes** platelayer & **Helen Baillie**. Informant David Innes father. (BMD D 1878 690 ¹⁸).

- 2.vii. William Innes was born 16 Jun 1873 at Oakbank, parish of Kirknewton. s/o **David Innes** railway platelayer & **Helen ms Baillie**

(married 11 Dec 1857 at Currie), informant father (BMD B 1873 690 ¹⁹)

On 14 Feb 1896 **William Innes**, shale miner age 22 17 Deans Row, married **Lizzie Ritchie**, 22, domestic servant Stable Rows, d/o Telfer Ritchie blacksmith and Lizzie ms Howe, by William Kirk E N minister, witness Angus Innes, Agnes Johnston. William is s/o **David Innes** gen'l labourer & **Ellen ms Baillie** deceased (BMD M 1896 662/1 ²⁰).

- 2.viii. Angus Innes was born 3 Apr 1876 at Oakbank, Kirknewton s/o **David Innes** railway platelayer & **Helen ms Baillie** (m 11 Dec 1857 at Currie) (BMD B 1876 690 ²¹).

On 13 Dec 1901 at Abercorn, Church of Scotland, **Angus Innes** shale miner 27 Livingstone married **Annie Potter** 30 Philipshouse, Abercorn, d/o Thomas Potter general labourer & Margaret ms Aitken, by John Wallace minister Abercorn, witness Alexander Innes , Annie Potter. Angus is s/o **David Innes** platelayer retired & **Helen ms Baillie** (BMD M 1901 661 ²²).

- 2.ix. James Maxwell Innes was born 23 Feb 1879 at Oakbank, Kirknewton, s/o **David Innes** railway platelayer & **Helen ms Baillie** m Dec 1857 at Currie, informant father (BMD B 1879 690 ²³).

On 10 Mar 1905 **James Baillie (sic) Innes**, shale miner bachelor age 26 residing Livingstone married **Barbara Watson Sommerville**, domestic servant age 20, Winchburgh, Kirkliston, daughter of Adam Sommerville farm servant & Annie ms Watson. By Hugh Armstrong, MA BA minister of Winchburgh parish. Witness David Innes, Marion Sommerville James is s/o **David Innes** plate layer deceased & **Helen Baillie** deceased (BMD M 1905 687 ²⁴).
